Introduction of the UFI code for hazardous mixtures in the hands of consumers will presumably be postponed by one year

The ECHA has announced that CARACAL, a group of experts for REACH and CLP, has unanimously approved the changes proposed by the European Commission for Annex VIII of the CLP. The Commission will be issuing a delegated legal act which, among other things, will postpone the first date for harmonized notification of mixtures intended for consumers from 1 January 2020 to 1 January 2021. It is expected that this act will take effect this year. The other schedules of EU Regulation 2017/542 (Annex VIII, CLP) will not be affected.

Updated Schedule

- 01.01.2021: Consumer products as well as semi-finished products used in consumer products and products for use by professionals
- 01.01.2024: Products for industrial use
- 01.01.2025: End of the transition period for products notified nationally before 01.01.2021
